





- City Will Pose A Design Guideline For Consideration
- Attendees Will Raise Hands In Affirmation / Support
- Design Guidelines Receiving Consensus In Support (Or A Close Majority) Will Be Used To Develop Design Elements For Consideration
- Future Workshop “Consensus On Design Elements” Will Be Conducted With Similar Process; Elements With Clear Majority Support Will Be Incorporated Into Master Plan
