### Introduction

The open house began with a short introduction about the ATP planning process. Attendees were then asked to informally review and comment on four displayed posters.

Attendees were able to view posters summarizing the county online survey results, and the completed sidewalk assessments. They were also asked to provide input regarding the county roadway assessment and regional destinations.

Approximately 15 people attended the open house.
