

Design Project to Include:


- Widen Sidewalk to 8' In Width
- Maintain Existing Sidewalk Width Where ≥ 8'
- Minimum 11' Wide Driving Lanes
- Relocate Street Furniture Into Rocks

Proposed Design Guidelines:


- Widen Sidewalk To Provide 8' Clear Space For Pedestrians
- Minimum 11' Wide Driving Lanes
- Relocate Street Furniture To Back Of Sidewalk



Street Light Relocations:


- Moved to Back of Sidewalk; Not Within Rocks
 - o Reduces Construction Risk
 - Reduces Construction Cost
 - Maintains 8' Sidewalk In Front Of Lights With 2
 Exceptions
- Resulting Sidewalk Width: 8.2′ 9.6′

Design Exceptions



Street Light Relocations:

- Moved to Back of Sidewalk; Not Within Rocks
 - o Reduces Construction Risk
 - o Reduces Construction Cost
 - Maintains 8' Sidewalk In Front Of Lights With 2
 Exceptions







Street Geometry


- Includes Proposed Pedestrian Bulbouts
- Relocates Trash Cans To Maintain 8' Clear Ped Space
- Maintains Minimum 11' Driving Lanes
- Includes Full Width Asphalt Overlay Of Ocean Boulevard
- Includes Sharrows (Optional) & High Visibility Crosswalks Per Active Transportation Plan
- No reduction in on-street parking
- Reviewed By Fire Department And Navy; Both Support
