



Elevate Erie Plan Advisory Committee (PAC)

A Plan Advisory Committee (PAC) is being established to participate in the Elevate Erie Comprehensive Plan and Transportation Mobility Plan updates. These plans were updated in 2015 and 2018, respectively and the town began an update in late 2022.

The PAC will meet several times throughout the 18-month planning process. While the PAC does not serve in a decision-making capacity, their input will be important to creating a plan that reflects Erie's desired future.

The specific roles and responsibilities for the PAC include:

- Coordinate with other town initiatives
- Provide input on overall project strategy, community engagement plan and schedule
- Facilitate broad community engagement by sharing information with the community and gathering feedback
- Represent diverse community interests during the planning process
- Identify and develop a deep understanding of issues and opportunities
- Provide feedback on interim work products (at various project phases)
