


EB-5886B Estes Drive Extension

Add Bicycle lanes & Pedestrian Paths From Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to the Norfolk-Southern Railroad tracks



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Town of Chapel Hill is proposing to add bicycle lanes and pedestrian paths along Estes Drive Extension, from the intersection of Estes Drive and Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, to the Chapel Hill limits at the railroad crossing.

This project will connect to the existing bicycle lanes pedestrian paths now in place on Estes Drive and also to the proposed path for the Bolin Creek Greenway Extension. The project is approximately 1.3 miles in length.




Option 1

Option 2


Separated Bike Lanes on both sides of Estes Drive and 10-ft Multi-use Path South side of Estes Drive


Option 3

Option 4


7-ft Bike Lane/Paved Shoulder on West side of Estes Drive with 11-ft Multi-use Path on the East/South side of Estes Drive
